

Indoor Car Boot | Terms & Conditions

Pitch Booking

- Bookings are accepted by completing the online booking form, on a first come first served basis.
- All pitches must be booked in advance unless otherwise agreed by the organiser.
- Payment must be made in full upon entry to the event, prior to set-up. We accept cash, or card payments.

Arrival and Set-Up

- Sellers must arrive during the designated set-up times.
- One parking space is allocated free of charge per pitch for the duration of the event only; drivers must register their vehicle at reception upon arrival.
- Pitches must be set up only within the allocated space provided.

Items for Sale

- Sellers are responsible for ensuring all items offered for sale comply with UK laws and regulations. The sale of illegal, counterfeit, dangerous, offensive, age-restricted, recalled, or prohibited items is strictly forbidden.
- The organiser reserves the right to request the removal of any unsuitable items.
- The sale of food and drink is strictly prohibited.

Health and Safety

- Sellers must keep their pitch area safe, tidy, and free from hazards.
- Any accidents, injuries, or incidents must be reported to the organiser immediately.
- Extension leads are not permitted.
- Stall holders are not permitted to operate or move Riverside folding tables.

Waste and Cleanliness

- Sellers must remove all unsold items, rubbish, and waste from their pitch at the end of the event. The Riverside Centre does not provide recycling or waste disposal facilities.
- Failure to leave the pitch clean may result in refusal of future bookings. Tables hired from The Riverside Centre must be covered. Scratched or damage caused to property or facilities at the car boot sale will be liable for the full cost of repair or replacement.

Dogs

- Dogs are not permitted in the building under any circumstances, other than registered ability dogs.

Liability

- All property is brought onto the site at the owner's risk.
- The organiser accepts no responsibility for loss, theft, damage or injury to property and vehicles whilst onsite, or for any transactions between buyers and sellers.

Pitch Cancellations

- The organiser reserves the right to cancel the event, in which case a refund or transfer to a future date may be offered.

Conduct

- Sellers must behave in a respectful manner towards staff, traders, and visitors.
- Any abusive, threatening, or disruptive behaviour may result in immediate removal from the site without refund.

Acceptance

- By booking and occupying a pitch, sellers agree to comply with these Terms & Conditions and any instructions given by the event organisers.

Organiser's Right:

The Riverside Centre reserves the right to refuse entry or remove any seller who breaches these Terms & Conditions.

The organiser reserves the right to cancel or postpone the car boot sale due to unforeseen circumstances beyond their reasonable control. In such cases, participants will be notified as soon as possible.

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
